

MASKS, GOWNS & FACE SHIELDS NEEDED

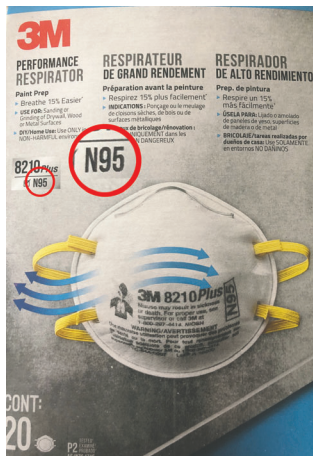
Dear Community Members,
